

Legal Representation for Children and Youth (LRCY) Reimbursement for Extended Travel Table

March 1, 2009

LRCY's Extended Travel Tables provide lawyers with allowable reimbursement amounts on authorized LRCY business travel between communities. Included in the tables are factors to calculate allowable reimbursement amounts for approved air travel costs. Each LRCY table is generally aligned to Provincial Judicial Boundaries.

Key considerations in use of the charts:

1. The Tables include distances and travel allowances between Alberta communities.
2. Some LRCY Regions have upper reimbursement limits for LRCY business travel.
3. LRCY defines out-of-town to be one-way inter-community travel greater than 35 kilometers.
4. Using the appropriate LRCY Region Table, select the '**FROM**' location (typically your office) and the '**TO**' location (e.g., the court or client site) to determine the reimbursement permitted for the one-way trip. Reimbursement for the return trip equals the amount allowed for the initial trip.
5. Each LRCY Extended Travel Chart is comprised of the following elements:
 - FROM (community)** – Departure point. i.e., Typically the city/town identified as the Lawyer's base of operations.
 - TO (community)** – Destination point. i.e., The city/town in which the child or youth resides or the location of the court case or Appeal Panel.
 - KMs One-Way** - The distance in kilometers between the **FROM** and **TO** communities as defined by LRCY.
 - KM Max Claimable** - The distance in kilometers that is claimable for LRCY business travel between the **FROM** and **TO** communities.
 - KM Charge Max** - The number of dollars that is claimable for LRCY business travel between the **FROM** and **TO** communities.
 - Time Charge Max** - The number of dollars that is claimable for Lawyer's time spent traveling on LRCY business between the **FROM** and **TO** communities.
